Applicants for Journal Membership must be:

- an Editor-in-Chief of a peer-reviewed scholarly journal; or
- a company or body whose primary business and object is publishing that includes the publishing of peer-reviewed scholarly journals.

Rates are based on the frequency of publication

CONTINUOUS PUBLICATION

Publishing companies that wish to join COPE but do not have a discrete journal product published in intervals will be charged according to the number of articles that they publish a year.

SUBSCRIPTION RATES 2013

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP AND ASSOCIATE CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Individuals may apply for associate membership, which is £50 per annum.

Companies may apply for associate corporate membership which is £150 per annum.

The eligibility criteria for associate membership and associate corporate membership are that the applicant must be a person or company who is interested in COPE's objects and who is working in or associated with the publication of peer-reviewed scholarly journals or has a significant interest in safeguarding the integrity of the academic record and who is NOT eligible for Full Membership.
