

## SUBSCRIPTION RATES 2009

### JOURNALS

Applicants for Journal Membership must be:

- an Editor-in-Chief of a peer-reviewed scholarly journal; or
- a company or body whose primary business and object is publishing that includes the publishing of peer-reviewed scholarly journals.

If a company wishes to register fewer than five journals then cumulative journal by frequency of publication rates apply.

Journals published fortnightly or weekly are not eligible to be included into bulk corporate membership and should be paid for separately.

### CONTINUOUS PUBLICATION

Publishing companies that wish to join COPE but do not have a discrete journal product published in intervals may pay according to the following rates:

Turnover or expenditure based on (for not-for-profit organisations) annual direct scholarly and professional publishing expenditure (i.e. production, marketing and distribution but not salaries or indirect overheads) or, for-profit companies, annual income (gross revenue before all deductions other than sales tax) related to scholarly and professional publishing.

### ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP AND ASSOCIATE CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Individuals or companies may apply for associate membership, which for individuals is £50 per annum and for companies follows the same schedule above for Continuous Publication members. The eligibility criteria are that the applicant must be a person or company who is interested in COPE's objects and who is working in or associated with the publication of peer-reviewed scholarly journals or has a significant interest in safeguarding the integrity of the academic record and who is not eligible for Full Membership.
